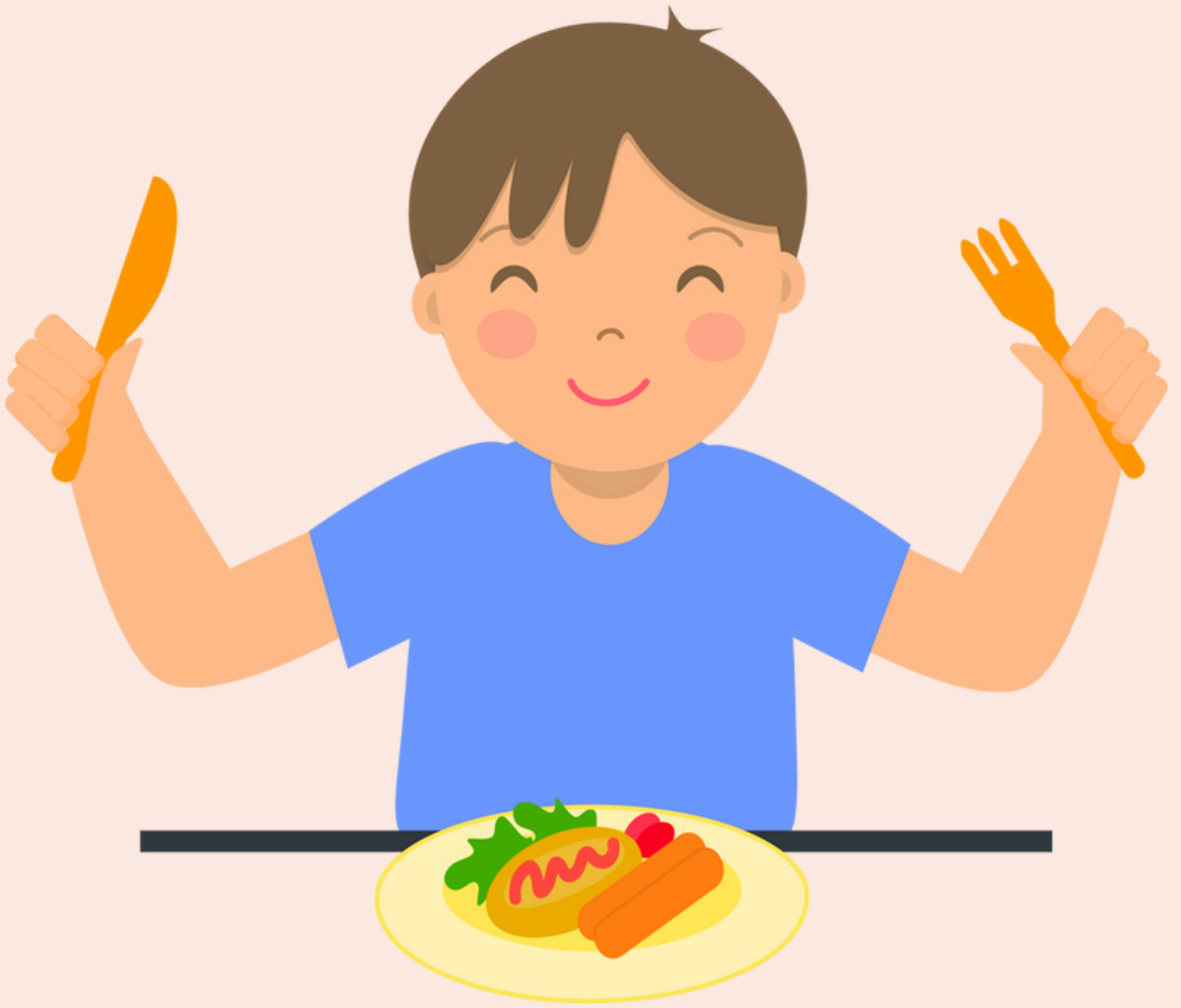

MEAL, TELL HIM TO BRING HIS PLATE OR
HIS GLASS**
